This 3 or 4 day courses (dependant on delegate numbers) is aimed specifically at Supervisors & Line Management. Designed to provide managers with the knowledge and tools to tackle the health and safety issues they are responsible for within their departments/teams.

Individuals will have an understanding of their responsibilities by covering the following modules of the course.

- Understanding Responsibilities
- Assessing Risks
- Investigating Incidents
- Understanding Hazards
- Controlling Risks
- Measuring Performance

- Recognise the importance of integrating health and safety within other business requirements to minimise overall risk.
- Be able to take into account health and safety aspects during planning, decision making and managing work activities.
- Giving individuals the health and safety tools and knowledge they need to comply with their legal responsibilities
