RISK ASSESSMENT

OVERVIEW

The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations require every employer to make a suitable and sufficient assessment of the health and safety risks to employees and others not in their employment to which their undertakings give rise, in order to put in place appropriate control measures.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This 1-day course provides individuals with the knowledge and understanding of the risk assessment process and the skills required to undertake suitable and sufficient risk assessments.

- The course content is based on the Health and Safety Executive's Five Steps to Risk Assessment.
- The assessment completed within the training is fit-for-purpose relating directly to the individual's workplace and testing the application of learning in a practical context.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Through practical knowledge and skills, individuals will:

- Understand the importance of Risk Assessment (the reasons for conducting them and the main legislative requirements).
- Understand the principles of controlling risks (identifying main H&S hazard and listing control measures that can reduce risks). Understand how a Risk Assessment is undertaken (describe the stages involved and outline the circumstances for review).
